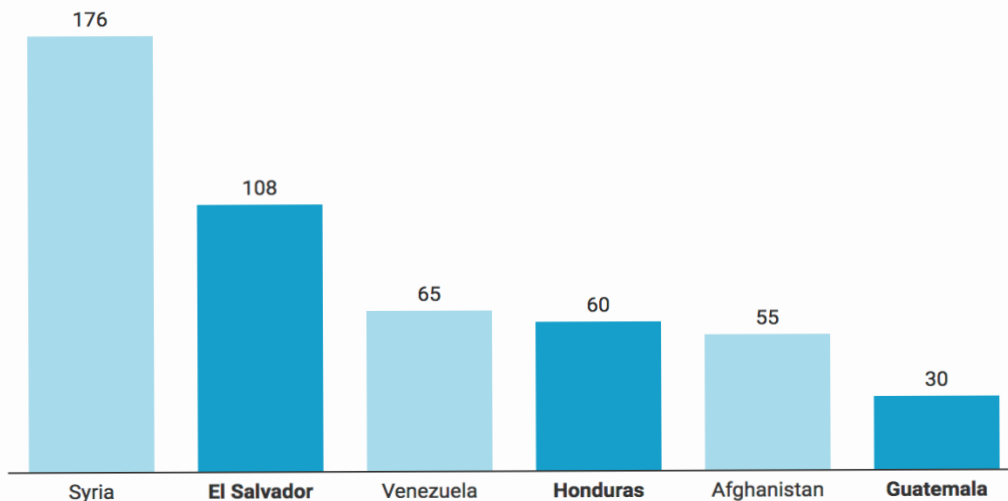


According to a 2016 survey, 83 percent of Hondurans believe the police are corrupt. Children and families often leave the country because they have no one to turn to for protection.
